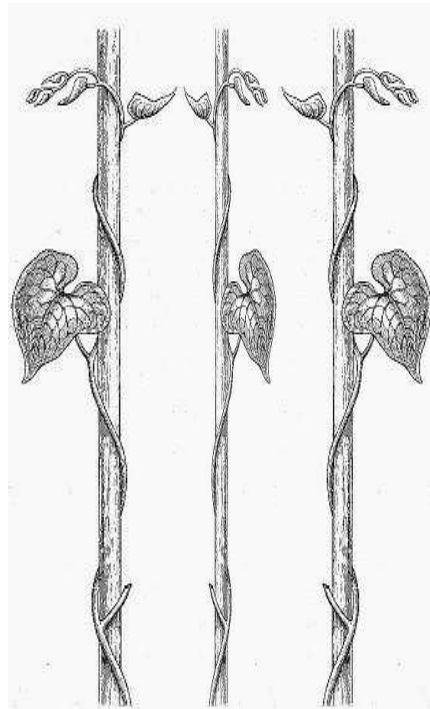

## Introducing William Tarkovsky

William Tarkovsky is founder of New Creationism: the philosophy that we can create the world anew on the basis of humanism, sustainability and service.

He is author of the philosophical work The Book of New Creation, a poetic formulation of the tenets of new creationism.

William has over two thousand *facebook* friends and uses *facebook* as a means of sharing his insights into the relationship between humans and the biological world. He is gathering around him a group of friends and followers who are re-branding “creationism” as an environmentalist slogan.

## Introducing Luke Andreski

William Tarkovsky is intimately connected with the author Luke Andreski.

Luke Andreski is a very British writer. He is reticent; modest; a little inarticulate. He is William Tarkovsky's shy alter ego.

Luke Andreski imagined, when he first established William upon the internet as an 'eco-activist' and 'virtual messiah', that he was demonstrating the timeliness and need for a green visionary, as detailed in his novel Green Messiah. Luke was unprepared for two important developments.

The first of these was the warm welcome given William by his *facebook* friends. It immediately became apparent that William is *experienced by others* as someone who deserves to exist.

The second unexpected development is that William Tarkovsky soon became a dominant force in Luke Andreski's life. William Tarkovsky is the poet-visionary that Luke Andreski ceased to be as he emerged from his troubled adolescence. William has an inner certainty, a clarity and a confidence in his philosophy to which Luke can only aspire.

Following his release into the world, William Tarkovsky quickly assumed ownership of The Book of New Creation, finessing it through a series of *facebook* postings to become more inclusive, more tolerant of other perspectives, and more focussed upon connecting with nature and with one another. His later *facebook* postings continue this theme and will be released in a subsequent work.

Luke Andreski writes:

"For me, William Tarkovsky has been a revelation. He has grasped existence with both hands and given life to a philosophical and poetic individual for whom I am only a distant memory. I am glad he has come into the world. I await with great interest his future writings, his next tentative steps towards a greater reality and his future interactions with his followers and friends."

## Biographical Details

William Tarkovsky's early life is largely rooted – as might be said of many visionaries – in fiction. Early in this millennium he abandoned family, work and friends to set up the Temple of New Creation in Finchley, North London. The temple has since been fire-bombed, fortunately with no casualties. His subsequent activities have been largely internet based, with the release of a number of youtube videos, *facebook* publication of The Book of New Creation and extensive networking around the globe.
